

Potassium Phosphate Buffer Solution

It has been used experimentally, for instance to study arteries ex vivo, in Langendorff heart preparations, and during isolated muscle testing of mammalian skeletal muscles. Sometimes glucose is added as an energy source and phenol red is used as a pH indicator.

Tyrode's solution It must be gassed with 95% oxygen and N₂, 5% carbon dioxide when used for cell culture applications and physiology experiments in order to achieve an appropriate pH. It resembles lactated Ringer's solution, but contains magnesium, a sugar (usually glucose) as an energy source and uses bicarbonate and phosphate as a buffer instead of lactate.
