After earning a degree in political science at the University of Padua, he moved to Milan to complete a master's degree in Cinema and Television Production. In Milan he worked freelance for several film production companies, producing advertisements and music videos. dcf13c54d7 The initiative was conceived by Teresa Noce and the Unione donne italiane (Italian Women's Union, UDI), and was promoted by the Italian Communist Party (PCI). The outskirts of Milan were full of impoverished children, and Noce asked her PCI comrades in Reggio Emilia if they would be willing to host some of the children during the upcoming winter. Reggio Emilia offered to host 2,000 children. Other cities in Emilia-Romagna followed suit, including Parma, Piacenza, Modena, Bologna, and Ravenna. On 16 December 1945, the first train departed from Milan and travelled to Reggio Emilia, carrying 1,800 children. Originally a fief of the Sanframondo family from 1151 to 1460, it passed to the Carafa family in 1483. In the 17th century, it became the seat of the bishops of the Telese diocese, which in 1986 evolved into the Diocese of Cerreto Sannita-Telese-Sant'Agata de' Goti. During the first and the second night of the show, each act performed two songs, and only one song per act was allowed to continue the competition, as a result of votes received by public and journalists. After the third night, Riccardo Sinigallia's entry, "Prima di andare via", was disqualified for being performed during a concert preceding the competition.
