Gemeinschaft and Gesellschaft Loomis appeared in 1940 as Fundamental Concepts of Gemeinschaft (German pronunciation: [gə'mainʃaft]) and Gesellschaft ([gə'zɛlʃaft]), generally translated as "community and society", are categories which were used by the German sociologist Ferdinand Tönnies in order to categorize social relationships into two types. An English translation of the 8th edition 1935 by Charles P. Max Weber, a founding figure in sociology, also wrote extensively about the relationship between Gemeinschaft and Gesellschaft. The Gesellschaft is associated with modern society and rational self-interest, which weakens the traditional bonds of family and local community that typify the Gemeinschaft.
