Assessing and enforcing compliance have become issues in China-US trade relations, including how China's noncompliance creates benefits for its own economy. Its membership has been contentious, with substantial economic and political effects on other

countries (some times referred to as the China shock) and controversies over the mismatch between the WTO framework and China's economic model. Coordinating Committee for Multilateral Export Controls However, CoCom faced criticism for weak enforcement and inconsistent application among member states. CoCom officially disbanded on March 31, 1994. Operating through informal consensus, CoCom maintained extensive control lists covering arms, nuclear materials, and dual-use technologies. However, many of its export restrictions remained in effect among member nations until they were formally replaced by the Wassenaar Arrangement in 1996.
