It is thought to be the second-oldest surviving play of Sophocles, preceded by Ajax, which was written around the same period. A daughter's attitude of desire for her father and hostility toward her mother is referred to as the feminine (or female) Oedipus complex. The general concept was considered by Sigmund Freud in The Interpretation of Dreams (1899), although the term itself was introduced in his paper "A Special Type of Choice of Object Made by Men" (1910) c2cd88383c
