Intel has only ever supported the Mesa drivers on Linux systems. Google uses the Freedreno driver in Mesa in some Chromebooks with Qualcomm processors. Systems with Nvidia cards usually use the proprietary Nvidia GeForce driver, but there are ongoing efforts to write Mesa Nvidia drivers called Nouveau and NVK. As of 2026, NVK is still usually slower than the proprietary driver, but the performance gap is continually decreasing as it is developed further. 01427cb1da Fuchsia is named for the color fuchsia, which is a combination of pink and purple.
