Many authentic elements survive, such as iron window frames, ammunition. It is located near the Hospital of Lithuanian University of Health Sciences. The Seventh Fort is one of the best surviving examples of a two-rampart fort, showing the typical design of a 19th-century Russian brick fort. The Seventh Fort opened its gates to the visitors in spring 2011 for the first

time in its history. The first owner of fort was the 11th company of Kaunas Fortress Artillery (Imperial Russian Army). In 1915, German Army occupied the Fort without resistance c396b04946
