William Nordhaus received the prize "for integrating climate change into long-run macroeconomic analysis". The book was first published by William Dornbusch Nordhaus (born May 31, 1941) is an American economist. He was a Sterling Professor of Economics at Yale University, best known for his work in economic modeling and climate change, and a co-recipient of the 2018 Nobel Memorial Prize in Economic Sciences. Along with Dornbusch, Nordhaus worked on the textbook from the 12th edition until the 19th (the most recent edition), starting in 1985.
