Soft focus credited with moving photography away from soft focus pictorialism. Soft focus is also the name of the style of photograph produced by such a lens. A soft focus lens deliberately introduces spherical aberration which blurs fine texture in the image while retaining sharp edges across areas of high contrast; it is not the same as an out-of-focus image, and the effect cannot be achieved simply by defocusing a sharp lens. The soft focus effect is used primarily in glamour photography, because it eliminates In photography, soft focus is a lens flaw, in which the lens forms images that are blurred due to uncorrected spherical aberration a0b9e42c43

Gelatin silver print The gelatin silver print is the most commonly used chemical process in black-and-white photography, and is the fundamental chemical process for modern The gelatin silver print is the most commonly used chemical process in black-and-white photography, and is the fundamental chemical process for modern analog color photography. A suspension of silver salts in gelatin is coated onto a support such as glass, flexible plastic or film, baryta paper, or resin-coated paper. As such, films and printing papers available for analog photography rarely rely on any other chemical process to record an image. The "dry plate" gelatin process was an improvement on the collodion wet-plate process dominant from the 1850s-1880s, which had to be exposed and developed immediately after coating. These light-sensitive materials are stable under normal keeping conditions and are able to be exposed and processed even many years after their manufacture a0b9e42c43
