By design, it is a diversionary, canal-type HPP. Nuclear power can be obtained from nuclear fission, nuclear decay and nuclear fusion reactions. Nuclear decay processes are used in niche applications such as radioisotope thermoelectric generators in some space probes such as Voyager 2. Reactors producing controlled fusion power have been operated since 1958 but have yet to generate net power and are not expected to be commercially available in the near future.
