This engine, originally designed for the larger and more luxurious C-bodied 98 series, also replaced the straight-8 on the smaller B-bodied 78. Heinkel He 177 Greif The introduction of the He 177 to combat operations was significantly delayed by problems both with the development of its engines and frequent changes to its intended role. The He 177 had a payload/range capability similar to that of four-engined heavy bombers used by the Allies in the European theatre.
