When the last letter of each new line (or other recurring feature) forms a word it is called a telestich (or telestic); the combination of an acrostic and a telestich in the same composition is called a double acrostic (e 7dfca7a94e

Phonics Phonics is also known as the alphabetic principle or the alphabetic code. mini-lessons, differentiated learning, cueing, leveled reading, shared reading, guided reading, independent reading and sight words. To use phonics is to teach the relationship between the sounds of the spoken language (phonemes), and the letters (graphemes) or groups of letters or syllables of the written language. It can be used with any writing system that is alphabetic, such as that of English, Russian, and most other languages. According to a survey in 2010 Phonics is a method for teaching reading and writing to beginners. Phonics is also sometimes used as part of the process of teaching Chinese people (and foreign students) to read and write Chinese characters, which are not alphabetic, using pinyin, which is alphabetic 7dfca7a94e
