Almost always, these activities require inscription equipment, either digital or physical: chisels, pencils, brushes, chalk, dyes, keyboards, touchscreens, etc. ; each of these tools has unique affordances that influence writers' workflows. and develops thinking. The goal of critical thinking is to form a judgment through the application of rational, skeptical, and unbiased analyses and evaluation.
