The analysis estimated that global food waste was 931 million tonnes of food waste (about 121 kg per capita) across three sectors: 61 percent from households, 26 percent from food service and 13 percent from retail. A 2021 meta-analysis, that did not include food lost during production, by the United Nations Environment Programme found that food waste was a

challenge in all countries at all levels of economic development. Overall, about one-third of the world's food is thrown away. A similar amount is lost on top of that by feeding human-edible food to farm animals (the net effect wastes an estimated 1144 kcal/person/day) b84d1e267d
