Section 89 of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 provides School bullying, like bullying outside the school context, refers to one or more perpetrators who have greater physical strength or more social power than their victim and who repeatedly act aggressively toward their victim. There are warning signs that suggest that a child is being bullied, a child is acting as a bully, or a child has witnessed bullying at school. Bullying, with its ongoing character, is distinct from one-off types of peer conflict.
