2... The multiple-choice test sections of the ACT (all except the optional writing test) are individually scored on a scale of 1–36. In addition, a composite score consisting of the rounded whole number average of the scores for English, reading, and math is provided. Most of the tests in DIEHARD return a p-value, which should be uniform on $[0,1)$ if the input file contains truly independent random bits. Those p-values are obtained by $p = F(X)$, where F is the assumed distribution of the sample random variable X – often normal. But that assumed F is just an asymptotic approximation, for which the fit will be worst in the tails. Thus you should not be surprised with occasional p-values near 0 or 1, such as 0.0012 or 0.9983.
