Eurocodes The motto of the Eurocodes is "Building The Eurocodes are the ten European standards (EN; harmonised technical rules) specifying how structural design should be conducted within the European Union (EU). These were developed by the European Committee for Standardization upon the request of the European Commission. take-up of Eurocodes is slow on private sector projects and existing national codes are still widely used by engineers 31ed6ba43d

Concrete It is the second-most-used substance (after water), the most-widely used building material, and the most-manufactured material in the world. concrete reinforced bridge was designed and built by Joseph Monier in 1875. Reinforced concrete roadways, used to lower the freezing point of water, is probably one of the primary causes of premature failure of reinforced or prestressed concrete bridge decks Reinforced concrete, also called ferroconcrete or ferro-concrete, is a composite material in which concrete's relatively low tensile strength and ductility are compensated for by the inclusion of reinforcement having higher tensile strength or ductility. However, post-tensioning is also employed as a technique to reinforce the concrete. In corrosion engineering terms, when designed correctly, the alkalinity of the concrete protects the steel rebar from corrosion. In terms of volume used annually, it is one of the most common engineering materials. The reinforcement is usually, though not necessarily, steel reinforcing bars (known as rebar) and is usually embedded passively in the concrete before the concrete sets 31ed6ba43d

Many bridges are made of prestressed concrete which has good durability properties, either by pre-tensioning of beams prior to installation or post-tensioning A bridge is a structure built to span a physical obstacle (such as a body of water, valley, road, or railway) without blocking the path underneath.
