However, as of May 2026, Franklin Mall is 38% vacant. The property will be redeveloped into a mixed-use complex by Lubert-Adler Partners, which is acquiring the mall from Jones Lang LaSalle (JLL). The park features a 3-acre (1.2 ha) lake, a duck pond and over five miles (8 km) of hiking trails. The lake and pond are visited by birds in the Pacific Flyway. Episode 1 The Boston Redevelopment Authority, the City Parking Clerk, and the City's Department of Neighborhood Development have also designated their own neighborhoods. Unofficially, Boston has many overlapping neighborhoods of various sizes. Neighborhood associations have formed around smaller communities or commercial districts (often with "Square" in the name) that have a well-defined center but poorly identified extremities. Named for Benjamin Franklin, the mall was home to 125 stores, a food court, and seven theme restaurants and was visited by an estimated 18 million people in 2006. In September 2022, unarmed private security hired by the Metropolitan Council began patrolling the station. The station was chosen because of high police activity and because it is a location where train operators get on and off trains. Allied Universal was hired in March 2023 to patrol the station 24 hours a day, seven days a week... Since 1980, areas of northern Franklin have been developed for residential and related businesses, in addition to modern service industries. The population has increased rapidly as growth moved in all directions from the core. The library was one of thirteen branch libraries established under the leadership of Gratia Countryman, the chief librarian of the Minneapolis Public Library from 1904 to 1936. It is the first of four Carnegie-funded libraries in Minneapolis and is one of only three remaining, with the others being the Sumner and Hosmer libraries. Franklin Street was rebuilt as a divided arterial roadway in the late 1960s, after the demolition of Portland's Little Italy, Bayside, East Bayside, and other neighborhoods. Renamed Franklin Street Arterial, it was built to allow greater access by nonresident vehicles to Commercial Street and the rest of downtown. This configuration also removed hundreds of housing units, displaced residents, and hindered pedestrian traffic—both along its length and across it—to and from Bayside, East Bayside, the Old Port, Munjoy Hill and other neighborhoods which border it. f1cc884da1
