Retainage The use Retainage is a portion of the agreed upon contract price deliberately withheld until the work is complete to assure that the contractor or subcontractor will satisfy its obligations and complete a construction project. A retention is money withheld by one party in a contract to act as security against incomplete or defective works. A mobilization payment is an advance payment to a contractor at the start of a project to assist in the beginning of operations. They have their origin in the Railway Mania of the 1840s but are now common across the industry, featuring in the majority of construction contracts. system instead. A typical retention rate is 5% of which half is

released at completion and half at the end of the defects liability period (often 12 months later). There has been criticism of the practice for leading to uncertainty on payment dates, increasing tensions between parties and putting monies at risk in cases of insolvency 0fb5070032
