The combination of this accumulated knowledge and the substantial numbers of Arabic-speaking scholars there made these areas intellectually attractive, as well as culturally and politically accessible to Latin scholars.

Egyptian Arabic contained many critical “errors” vis-à-vis Classical Arabic, according to al-Maghribi, it was also related to Arabic in other respects. With few waves of Egyptian Arabic, locally known as Colloquial Egyptian, or simply as Masri, is the most widely spoken vernacular Arabic variety in Egypt. These factors help make it the most widely spoken and by far the most widely studied variety of Arabic. It is part of the Afro-Asiatic language family, and originated in the Nile Delta in Lower Egypt.
