Convection When the cause of the convection is unspecified, convection due to the effects of thermal expansion and buoyancy can be assumed. The heat from the candle will cause a strong convection current Convection is single or multiphase fluid flow that occurs spontaneously through the combined effects of material property heterogeneity and body forces on a fluid, most commonly density and gravity (see buoyancy). Convection may also take place in soft solids or mixtures where particles can flow. gases can be demonstrated using a candle in a sealed space with an inlet and exhaust port

Oxygen therapy Oxygen therapy is often useful in chronic hypoxemia caused by conditions such as severe COPD or cystic fibrosis. g. Concentrated oxygen will allow combustion to proceed rapidly and energetically Oxygen therapy, also referred to as supplemental oxygen, is the use of oxygen as medical treatment. It can also be given through bypassing the airway, such as in ECMO therapy. although an ignition event (e. , heat or spark) is needed to trigger combustion. Supplemental oxygen can also refer to the use of oxygen enriched air at altitude. It may also be prophylactically given to

maintain blood oxygen levels during the induction of anesthesia. Acute indications for therapy include hypoxemia (low blood oxygen levels), carbon monoxide toxicity and cluster headache. Oxygen can be delivered via nasal cannula, face mask, or endotracheal intubation at normal atmospheric pressure, or in a hyperbaric chamber c05745ff4e

Convective flow may be transient (such as when a multiphase mixture of oil and water separates) or steady state (see convection cell). The convection may be due to gravitational, electromagnetic or fictitious body forces. He is best known for Boyle's law, which describes the inversely proportional relationship between the absolute pressure and volume of a gas, if the temperature is kept constant within a closed system.

Michael Faraday He similarly discovered the principles of electromagnetic. Faraday also established that magnetism could affect rays of light and that there was an underlying relationship between the two phenomena. Although Faraday received little formal education, as a self-made man, he was one of the most influential scientists in history.
