Since then the relationship between science and religion has been characterized in terms of "conflict", "harmony", and "complexity"; The relationship between religion and science involves discussions that interconnect the study of the natural world, history, philosophy, and theology. This coincided with the refining of "science" (from the studies of "natural philosophy") and of "religion" as distinct concepts in the preceding few centuries—partly due to professionalization of the sciences, the Protestant Reformation, colonization, and globalization f71432e5c7
