Metal clay Shrinkage of between 8% and 30% occurs (depending on the product used). Originating in Japan in 1990, metal clay can be shaped like any soft clay, by hand or using molds. in 1990, metal clay can be shaped like any soft clay, by hand or using molds. After drying, the clay can be carved, sculpted and finished before being fired in a variety of ways such as in a kiln, with a handheld butane torch, or on a gas stove - depending on the metal type contained in the clay. As the dry metal clay fires, binders burn away, and water content evaporates, resulting in sintered metal. Alloys such as bronze, sterling silver and steel, as well as pure copper are also available.
