A maritime village existed along the mouth of the Pescara River as early as the 1st century BC, known as Aternum or Ostia Aterni. In the centuries that followed, Pescara's strategic location, serving as the gateway to the great valley that divides Abruzzo, consistently influenced its economic and social development. Initially, it functioned primarily as a military stronghold for the defense of southern kingdoms, but from the second half of the 19th century, it became known for its thriving commercial activity and seaside tourism. After the fall of the Fascist regime in Italy and the end of World War II, Italian politics and society were dominated by Christian Democracy (DC), a broad-based Christian political party, from 1946 to 1994. From the late 1940s until 1991, the opposition was led by the Italian Communist Party (PCI). Christian Democracy governed uninterrupted during this period, dominating every cabinet and providing nearly every prime minister. It governed primarily with the support of an array of minor parties from the centre-left to the centre-right, including the Italian Socialist Party (PSI), Italian Democratic Socialist Party (PSDI), Italian Republican Party (PRI), and Italian Liberal Party (PLI), and even far-right parties like the Italian Social Movement (MSI). The Communist Party was excluded entirely from government, with the partial exception of the short-lived Historic Compromise, in which the PCI... The Italian Flag Day named Tricolour Day was established by law n. 671 of 31 December 1996, and is

held every year on 7 January. This celebration commemorates the first official adoption of the tricolour as a national flag by a sovereign Italian state, the Cispadane Republic, a Napoleonic sister republic of Revolutionary France, which took place in Reggio Emilia on 7 January 1797, on the basis of the events following the French Revolution (1789-1799) which, among its ideals, advocated national self-determination.
