Modern synthesis (20th century) The synthesis combined the ideas of natural selection, Mendelian genetics, and population genetics. It also related the broad-scale macroevolution seen by palaeontologists to the small-scale microevolution of local populations. The traditional view is that developmental biology played little part in the modern synthesis, but in his 1930 book *The modern synthesis* was the early 20th-century synthesis of Charles Darwin's theory of evolution and Gregor Mendel's ideas on heredity into a joint mathematical framework.
