Centre-left politics neoliberalism. Centre-left politics are contrasted with far-left politics that reject capitalism or advocate revolution. Ideologies commonly associated with it include social democracy, social liberalism, progressivism, and green politics. In the 1990s, Third Way politics emerged as a centrist variant of social democracy in Europe, and centre-left politics spread to Latin Centre-left politics is the range of left-wing political ideologies that lean closer to the political centre. Economically, the centre-left supports a mixed economy in a democratic capitalist system, often including economic interventionism, progressive taxation, and the right to unionize. Ideas commonly supported by the centre-left include welfare capitalism, social justice, liberal internationalism, and multiculturalism 707e41dadd
