Muhammad Zahir Howaida was born in 1945 in Sharistan, Daikundi, into a Hazara family After his birth, his father moved the family to Kabul and thereafter to the city of Mazar-e-Sharif in the Balkh province of northern Afghanistan. For much of his life, he kept his identity secret for fear of the backlash he would face for being linked to the Hazara, which was considered a stigma.
