Definitions and explanations of the underclass, as well as proposed solutions for managing or fixing the underclass problem have been highly debated. 652945a768 Unlike the proletariat of industrial workers in the 20th century, who lacked their own means of production and therefore sold their labor to survive, members of the precariat are only partially involved in labor. They must undertake extensive unremunerated activities that are essential to retaining access to jobs and decent earnings. Classic examples of such unpaid activities include continually searching and applying for work, as well as being expected to always be responsive to calls for gig work. 652945a768 Gunnar Myrdal is generally credited as the first proponent of the term underclass. Writing in the early 1960s on economic inequality in the U.S., Myrdal's underclass refers to a "class of unemployed,

Standing co-founded the Basic Income Earth Network (BIEN) in 1986 and has written widely in the areas of labour economics, active labour market policies, unemployment, labour market flexibility, structural adjustment programs and social protection. However he was opposed by Themistocles, who proposed the money be spent building warships for the Athenian navy. In the end, Themistocles' policy was the one adopted.

652945a768 Marx did not invent the term "reserve army of labour". It was already being used by Friedrich Engels in his 1845 book *The Condition of the Working Class in England*. What Marx did was theorize the reserve army of labour as a necessary part of the capitalist organization of work. 652945a768 Prior to what Marx regarded as the start of the capitalist era in human history (i.e. before the 16th century), structural unemployment on a mass scale rarely existed, other than that caused by natural disasters and wars.
