Notable exceptions are the earliest digital scholarly editions published Textual criticism is a branch of textual scholarship, philology, and literary criticism that is concerned with the identification of textual variants, or different versions, of either manuscripts (mss) or of printed books. This means that unintentional alterations were common when copying manuscripts by hand. Historically, scribes who were paid to copy documents may have been literate, but many were simply copyists, mimicking the shapes of letters without necessarily understanding what they meant cab2cab1

Comparison of analog and digital recording Advocates of digital point to the high levels of performance possible with digital audio, including excellent linearity in the audible band and low levels of noise and distortion. is usually a design goal of digital systems to limit high-level signals to prevent overload. Arguments for analog systems include the absence of fundamental error mechanisms which are present in digital audio systems, including aliasing and associated anti-aliasing filter implementation, jitter and quantization noise. Both techniques introduce errors and distortions in the sound, and these methods can be systematically compared.
