Case method In sharp contrast to many other teaching methods, the case method requires that instructors refrain from providing their own opinions about the decisions in question. It developed during the course of the twentieth-century from its origins in the casebook method of teaching law pioneered by Harvard legal scholar Christopher C. Langdell. Rather, the chief task of instructors who use the case method is asking students to devise, describe, and defend solutions to the problems presented by each case

Health psychology For example, chronically occurring environmental stressors affecting the hypothalamic–pituitary–adrenal axis, cumulatively, can harm health. Health psychologists take a biopsychosocial approach. In other words, health psychologists understand health to be the product not only of biological processes. Psychological factors can affect health directly. For example, certain behaviors can, over time, harm (smoking or consuming excessive amounts of alcohol) or enhance (engaging in exercise) health. Quantitative designs approach social phenomena through quantifiable evidence, and often rely on statistical analyses of many cases (or across intentionally designed treatments in an experiment) to create valid and reliable general claims.

All of these approaches to professional and academic research emphasize that monomethod research can be improved through the use of multiple data sources, methods, research methodologies, perspectives, standpoints, and paradigms. Mixed methods research is more specific in that it includes the mixing of qualitative and quantitative data, methods, methodologies, and/or paradigms in a research study or set of related studies. Another applicable, but less often used label, for multi or mixed research is methodological pluralism. One could argue that mixed methods research is a special case of multimethod research.
