Walter Dandy Dandy was the Walter Edward Dandy (April 6, 1886 – April 19, 1946) was an American neurosurgeon and scientist. numerous contributions to neurosurgery in particular and to medicine in general has increased as the field of neurosurgery has evolved. Dandy is credited with numerous neurosurgical discoveries and innovations, including the description of the circulation of cerebrospinal fluid in the brain, surgical treatment of hydrocephalus, the invention of air ventriculography and pneumoencephalography, the description of brain endoscopy, the establishment of the first intensive care

unit, and the first clipping of an intracranial aneurysm, which marked the birth of cerebrovascular neurosurgery. He is considered one of the founding fathers of neurosurgery, along with Victor Horsley and Harvey Cushing 7999ad2e5c

This uses Doppler ultrasound to assess blood flow through the major arteries in the brain, and can scan through bone. It is not usual for this technique to be referred to simply as "cranial ultrasound".
