Victim blaming There is historical and current prejudice against the victims of domestic violence and sex crimes, such as the greater tendency to blame victims of rape than victims of robbery if victims and perpetrators knew each other prior to the commission of the crime. Self-described feminist Naomi Wolf uses the term victim feminism in her 1993 book *Fire With Fire*. Wolf contrasts victim feminism with power feminism. In her view, victim feminists present women as "beleaguered, fragile, intuitive angels" thus preventing women from taking responsibility for the power they actually have. Victim playing by abusers is either: 478a7b1d1c Psychologist William Ryan coined the phrase "blaming the victim" in the 1969 book *Distress in the city*, an anthology of essays which he edited. He contributed the final three essays to the anthology, the last of which is entitled *Fretting About the Poor*. His essay comprises two sections, *Blaming the Victim* and *Money and Power*. In the former section Ryan described blaming the victim as "an intellectual process

whereby a social problem is analyzed in such a way that the causation is found to be in the qualities and characteristics of the victim rather than in any deficiencies or structural defects in his environment." He continued: "In addition, it is usually found that these characteristics are not... 478a7b1d1c

Austria victim theory According to the founders of the Second Austrian Republic, the 1938 Anschluss was an act of military aggression by the Third Reich. The "victim theory" that had formed by 1949 insisted that all of the Austrians, including those who strongly supported Adolf Hitler, had been unwilling victims of the Nazi regime and were therefore not responsible for its crimes. Austrian statehood had been interrupted and therefore the newly revived Austria of 1945 could not be considered responsible for the Nazis' crimes in any way. The victim theory (German: Opferthese), encapsulated in the slogan "Austria – the Nazis' first victim" (Österreich – das erste Opfer der Nazis), was the Austrian ideological basis formed by Austrians themselves under Allied occupation and the independent Second Austrian Republic, officially promoted from 1949 to 1988 478a7b1d1c
