Politicians expressed concern and called On April 9, 2017, at Chicago O'Hare International Airport, four paying customers were selected to be involuntarily deplaned from United Express Flight 3411 to make room for four deadheading employees. of the incident recorded by passengers went viral on social media, resulting in anger over the use of force shown. In the process of removing him, the security officers struck his face against an armrest, then dragged him – bloodied, bruised, and unconscious – by his arms down the aircraft aisle, past rows of onlooking passengers. Dao, a pulmonologist, refused to leave his seat when directed because he needed to see patients the following day. The incident is widely characterized by critics – and later by United Airlines itself – as an example of mishandled customer service 166bd2c50f

Unlike a defense, which tries only to demonstrate that God and evil can logically

Sallekhana (slendering) and kaya sallekhana (slendering the body) or bahya sallekhana (external slendering). It is the religious practice of voluntarily fasting to death by gradually reducing the intake of food and liquids. It is not considered a suicide by Jain scholars because it is not an act of passion, nor does it employ poisons or weapons. It is viewed in Jainism as the thinning of human passions and the body, and another means of destroying rebirth-influencing karma by withdrawing all physical and mental activities. It is described as "facing

The worldview A theodicy (from Ancient Greek θεός theos, "god" and δίκη dikē, "justice"), meaning 'vindication of God', is an argument in the philosophy of religion that attempts to resolve the problem of evil, which arises when all power (omnipotence) and all goodness (omnibenevolence) are attributed to God simultaneously 166bd2c50f

more members who have real A dysfunctional family is a family in which conflict, misbehavior and often child neglect or abuse on the part of individual parents occur continuously and regularly. Parents having grown up in a dysfunctional family may over-correct or emulate their own parents. Children that grow up in such families may think such a situation is normal. Dysfunctional families are primarily a result of two adults, one typically overtly abusive and the other codependent, and may also be affected by substance abuse or other forms of addiction, or often by an untreated mental illness. In some cases, the dominant parent will abuse or neglect their children and the other parent will not object, misleading a child to assume blame 166bd2c50f

Historic evidence such as nishidhi engravings suggest sallekhana was observed by both men and women, including queens, in Jain history. However, in the modern era, death through sallekhana has been a relatively uncommon event. There is debate about the practice from a right to life vs right to die and a freedom of religion viewpoint. 2020 Delhi riots Over a week after the violence had ended, hundreds of wounded were languishing in inadequately staffed medical facilities and corpses were being found in open drains. card and took a photograph of it before letting him leave. Of the 53 people killed, two-thirds were Muslims who were shot, slashed with repeated blows, or set on fire. By mid-March many Muslims had remained missing. The dead also included over a dozen Hindus, who were shot or assaulted.
