Technical analysis The efficacy of technical analysis is disputed by the efficient-market hypothesis, which states that stock market prices are essentially unpredictable, and research on whether technical analysis offers any benefit has produced mixed results. As a type of active management, it stands in contradiction to much of modern portfolio theory. It is distinguished from fundamental analysis, which considers a company's financial statements, health, and the overall state of the market and economy.

This normally involves various steps, like choosing a sample, collecting data from this sample, and interpreting the data. Examples are how to conceptualize the studied phenomena and what constitutes evidence for or against them. These descriptions and evaluations depend on philosophical background assumptions. terms "method" and "methodology". This way, it is assessed what advantages and disadvantages they have and for what research goals they may be used. A method is a structured procedure for bringing about a certain goal, like acquiring knowledge or verifying knowledge claims. It includes evaluative aspects by comparing different methods. The study of methods concerns a detailed description and analysis of these processes.
