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Formative assessment It also helps faculty
recognize where students are struggling and
address problems immediately. The goal of a
formative assessment is to monitor student
learning to provide ongoing feedback that
can help students identify their strengths
and weaknesses and target areas that need

work. It typically involves qualitative feedback (rather than scores) for both student and teacher that focuses on the details of content and performance.
