Skin cancer Skin cancer is the most commonly diagnosed form of cancer in humans. The choice of technique in reconstruction is Skin cancers are cancers that arise from the skin. Basal-cell cancer grows slowly and can damage the tissue around it but is unlikely to spread to distant areas or result in death. The first two, along with a number of less common skin cancers, are known as nonmelanoma skin cancer (NMSC). The goal of reconstructive surgery is the restoration of normal appearance and function. It occurs when skin cells grow uncontrollably, forming malignant tumors. There are three main types of skin cancers: basal-cell skin cancer (BCC), squamous-cell skin cancer (SCC) and melanoma.
