Gestonorone caproate is a progestin, or a synthetic progestogen, and hence is an agonist of the progesterone receptor, the biological target of progestogens like progesterone. Prostate cancer Those with high levels of PSA in their blood are at increased risk for developing prostate cancer. Diagnosis requires a biopsy of the prostate. A higher stage signifies a more advanced, more dangerous disease. Medical imaging is performed to look for cancer that has spread outside the prostate. If cancer is present, the pathologist assigns a Gleason score; a higher score represents a more dangerous tumor. Based on the Gleason score, PSA levels, and imaging results, a cancer case is assigned a stage 1 to 4. Bicalutamide It is typically used together with a gonadotropin-releasing

hormone (GnRH) analogue or surgical removal of the testicles to treat metastatic prostate cancer (mPC). Bicalutamide was also previously used as monotherapy to treat localized prostate cancer (LPC), but authorization for this use was withdrawn following unfavorable trial findings. To a lesser extent, it is used at high doses for locally advanced prostate cancer (LAPC) as a monotherapy without castration. Besides prostate cancer, bicalutamide is limitedly used in the treatment of excessive hair growth and scalp hair loss in women, as a puberty blocker and component of feminizing hormone therapy. Prostate cancer staging Clinical staging usually occurs before the first treatment and tumour presence is determined through imaging and rectal examination, while pathological staging is done after treatment once a biopsy is performed or the prostate is removed by looking at the cell types within the sample. Prostate cancer stage can be assessed by either clinical or pathological staging methods. Once patients are placed in prognostic categories, this information can contribute to the selection of an optimal approach to treatment. The laparoscopic and open forms of radical prostatectomy physically remove the entire prostate and reconstruct the urethra directly to the bladder. Laparoscopic radical prostatectomy and open radical prostatectomy differ in how they access the deep pelvis and generate operative views. In contrast to open radical prostatectomy, the laparoscopic radical prostatectomy makes no use of retractors and does not require that the abdominal wall be parted and stretched for the duration of the operation. c0defd2517 The cause is unclear. Risk factors include a family history, obesity, type 2 diabetes, not enough exercise, and erectile dysfunction. Medications like pseudoephedrine, anticholinergics, and calcium channel blockers may worsen symptoms. The underlying mechanism involves the prostate pressing on the urethra thereby making it difficult to pass urine out of the bladder.
