The minimum intelligent signal test was proposed by Chris McKinstry as "the The Turing test, originally called the imitation game by Alan Turing in 1949, is a test of a machine's ability to exhibit

intelligent behaviour equivalent to that of a human. The evaluator tries to identify the machine, and the machine passes if the evaluator cannot reliably tell them apart. Since the Turing test is a test of indistinguishability in performance capacity, the verbal version generalizes naturally to all of human performance capacity, verbal as well as nonverbal (robotic) 56bfdec356
