Parity of zero As a result, zero shares all the properties that characterize even numbers: for example, 0 is neighbored on both sides by odd numbers, any decimal integer has the same parity as its last digit—so, since 10 is even, 0 will be even, and if  $y$  is even then  $y + x$  has the same parity as  $x$ —indeed,  $0 + x$  and  $x$  always have the same parity.
