Philosophy of science Amongst its central questions are the difference between science and non-science, the reliability of scientific theories, and the ultimate purpose and meaning of science as a human endeavour. Ethical issues such as bioethics and scientific misconduct are often considered. Karl Popper criticized logical positivism and helped establish a modern set of standards for scientific methodology. Philosophy of science is both a theoretical and empirical discipline, relying on philosophical

theorising as well as meta-studies of scientific practice. assessing them. Philosophy of science focuses on metaphysical, epistemic and semantic aspects of scientific practice, and overlaps with metaphysics, ontology, logic, and epistemology, for example, when it explores the relationship between science and the concept of truth. Thomas Kuhn's 1962 book *Philosophy of science* is the branch of philosophy concerned with the foundations, methods, and implications of science

Although the positivist approach has been a recurrent theme in the history of Western thought, modern positivism was first articulated in the early 19th century by Auguste Comte. His school of sociological positivism holds that society, like the physical world, operates according to scientific laws. After Comte, positivist schools arose in logic, psychology, economics, historiography, and other fields of thought. Generally, positivists attempted to introduce scientific methods to their...

Mathematics The basic statements are not subject to proof because they are self-evident (postulates), or are Mathematics is a field of study that discovers and organizes methods, theories and theorems that are developed and proved for the needs of empirical sciences and mathematics itself. There are many areas of mathematics, which include number theory (the study of numbers), algebra (the study of formulas and related structures), geometry (the study of shapes and spaces that contain them), analysis (the study of continuous changes), and set theory (presently used as a foundation for all mathematics). accepted results (theorems) and a few basic statements

Pseudoscience It is not the same as junk science. Pseudoscience is often characterized by contradictory, exaggerated or unfalsifiable claims; reliance on confirmation bias rather than rigorous attempts at refutation; lack of openness to evaluation by other

experts; absence of systematic practices when developing hypotheses; and continued adherence long after the pseudoscientific hypotheses have been experimentally discredited. "Nonetheless, Lakatos did recognize the force of Kuhn's historical criticism of Popper – Pseudoscience consists of statements, beliefs, or practices that claim to be both scientific and factual but are incompatible with the scientific method. certain inadequacies in those of Karl Popper and Thomas Kuhn

John Philoponus, a Byzantine scholar in the 6th century, started to question Aristotle's teaching of physics, introducing the theory of impetus Science is a systematic discipline that builds and organises knowledge in the form of testable hypotheses and predictions about the universe. While referred to as the formal sciences, the study of logic, mathematics, and theoretical computer science are typically regarded as separate because they rely on deductive reasoning instead of the scientific method as their main methodology. Modern science is typically divided into two – or three – major branches: the natural sciences, which study the physical world, and the social sciences, which study individuals and societies. Meanwhile, applied sciences are disciplines that use scientific knowledge for practical purposes, such as engineering and medicine

Scientific method of invariance have been a theme in scientific writing, and especially physics, since at least the early 20th century. Scientific inquiry includes creating a testable hypothesis through inductive reasoning, testing it through experiments and statistical analysis, and adjusting or discarding the hypothesis based on the results. Historically, it was developed through the centuries from the ancient and medieval world. The basic idea here is that good The scientific method is an empirical method for acquiring knowledge that has been referred to while doing science since at least the 17th century. The scientific method involves careful observation coupled with rigorous skepticism, because cognitive assumptions can distort the interpretation of the observation

Knowledge Knowledge of facts, also called propositional knowledge, is often characterized as true belief that is distinct from opinion or guesswork by virtue of justification. of knowledge, like perception, provide basic reasons. These controversies intensified in the latter half of the 20th century due to a series of thought experiments called Gettier cases that provoked alternative definitions. Another view is that this role is played by certain self-evident truths, like the knowledge of one's Knowledge is an awareness of facts, a familiarity with individuals and situations, or a practical skill. While there is wide agreement among philosophers that propositional knowledge is a form of true belief, many controversies focus on justification. This includes questions like how to understand justification, whether it is needed at all, and whether something else besides it is needed

Mathematics involves the description and manipulation of abstract objects that consist

of either abstractions from nature or—in modern mathematics—purely abstract entities that are stipulated to have certain properties, called axioms.
