Henry John Temple, 3rd Viscount Palmerston He dominated British foreign policy from 1830 to 1865 when Britain stood at the height of its imperial power. A member of the Tory, Whig and Liberal parties, Palmerston was also the first Liberal prime minister. 1835–1841 and 1846–1851, responding to a series of conflicts in Europe. In 1852, Palmerston became Home Secretary in the government of the Earl of Aberdeen Henry John Temple, 3rd Viscount Palmerston (20 October 1784 – 18 October 1865), known as Lord Palmerston, was a British statesman and politician who served as prime minister of the United Kingdom from 1855 to 1858 and from 1859 to his death in 1865 e1a5f6a43f
