Project governance is a critical element of any project since the accountabilities and responsibilities associated with an organization's business as usual activities are laid down in its organizational governance arrangements; seldom does an equivalent framework exist to govern the development of its capital investments (projects). The resulting financial reports can be used internally by management or externally by other interested parties including investors, creditors and tax authorities.
