

Eyewitness Accounts Battles Of The Crimean War

Following the establishment of the Mahdist State in Sudan, and the subsequent threat to the regional status quo and to British-occupied Egypt, the British government decided to send an expeditionary force with the task of overthrowing the Khalifa. The commander of the force, Sir Herbert Kitchener, was also seeking revenge for the death of General Gordon, who had been killed when a Mahdist army captured Khartoum thirteen years earlier. On the morning of 2 September, some 35,000–50,000 Sudanese tribesmen under Abdullah attacked the British lines in a disastrous series of charges; later that morning the 21st Lancers charged and defeated another force that appeared on the British right flank. The Byzantines sent a squadron of 14 ships to pursue the dispersed monoxyla of the Rus'. They were sunk by the Ruthenian admiral Ivan Tvorimich, who also managed to rescue Prince Vladimir after the shipwreck. The Varangian Guard was also present. A 6,000-strong Ruthenian contingent under Vyshata, which did not take part in naval action, was captured and deported to Constantinople. Eight hundred of the Ruthenian prisoners were blinded. 83698e4ac5

Kara Fatima Khanum Contemporary British and French publications repeatedly identified her and her mounted followers as Kurdish, called her the "heroine Kara Fatma Hanım (كردستان خانم, literally "Black Fatma"; also rendered Kara Fatima Khanum, Fatima Hanoun, and, in Kurdish, Fata Reş) was a nineteenth-century Kurdish chieftain who commanded irregular cavalry during the Crimean War. Modern historian Martin van Bruinessen likewise describes her as the female chieftain of a Kurdish tribe from Marash. Contemporary British and French publications repeatedly identified her and her mounted followers as Kurdish, called her the "heroine of Kurdistan", and associated her with Marash. during the Crimean War 83698e4ac5

The reverse depicts a cannon standing upon the Imperial Russian flag, with an anchor and a mortar. The four flags of the allies are to the rear, their order identifying the country for which the medal was intended, either Great Britain, France or Sardinia. The identifying flag is the central right hand flag, positioned above the anchor, the Union Flag for Great Britain, the tricolour for France or the flag of the Kingdom of Sardinia, based on the Italian tricolore. Many of these figures, though, are estimates, and, where possible, a range of estimates is presented. Figures display numbers for all types of casualties when available (killed, wounded, missing, and sick) but may only include number killed due to a lack of total data on the event. Where possible, the list specifies whether or not prisoners are included in the count. 83698e4ac5 Ottoman records identify her personal name as Asiye, associate her administratively with the Cerid tribe in the Adana region, and call her the kethüda of one of its sections. Because the Cerid were commonly classified as Turkmen or Yörük, some modern works present a Cerid-Turkmen identity as an alternative to the Kurdish and Sinemilli identification. The son of Captain Robert William Dallas and his wife Lucy née Davidson, Dallas was born in Edgware, Hertfordshire, on 3 April 1827. He was educated firstly at Mr Allfred's Preparatory School in Tunbridge Wells, and then at Harrow School from January 1842. Playing cricket for Harrow, he played in two matches at Lord's; one against Eton College and the other against Winchester College, both of which were victories. Dallas left school in 1844, and purchased a commission on 16 May 1845 as an ensign in the 46th Regiment of Foot (commanded by a family friend), before being promoted to the rank of lieutenant in April 1848. Prior to this he had served in his regiments depot battalion, joining the main portion of the 46th when it returned from duty in Halifax, Nova Scotia, on 8 May.
