Dendroclimatology By combining multiple tree-ring studies (sometimes with other climate proxy records), scientists have estimated past regional and global climates. This allows extension backwards in time using deceased tree samples, even using samples from buildings or from Dendroclimatology is the science of determining past climates from trees (primarily properties of the annual tree rings). matching of the rings from sample to sample. Using tree rings, scientists have estimated many local climates for hundreds to thousands of years previous. Tree rings are wider when conditions favor growth, narrower when times are difficult. Other properties of the annual rings, such as maximum latewood density (MXD) have been shown to be better proxies than simple ring width 53d8115ec8

Infrared Nanospectroscopy (AFM-IR) The term was first used to denote a method that combined a tuneable free electron laser with an atomic force microscope (AFM, a type of SPM) equipped with a sharp probe that measured the local absorption of infrared light by a sample with nanoscale spatial resolution. AFM-IR combines the chemical analysis power of infrared spectroscopy and the high-spatial resolution of scanning probe microscopy (SPM). In the first paper on AFM-IR (atomic force microscope-infrared spectroscopy) or infrared nanospectroscopy is one of a family of techniques that are derived from a combination of two parent instrumental techniques.
