England won both legs, winning the overall 2013 Series. The 2013 Series consisted of two tournaments, held in Lyon, France and Bucharest, Romania 02d04294b4

As with the men's counterpart, the series winner was to be the team that collected the most points throughout the season, based on individual tournament finishes. 02d04294b4 Including the competition's previous incarnations as the Home Nations Championship and Five Nations Championship, it was the 119th edition of the tournament. Wales won the tournament for the second time in two years, the first time they had won back-to-back championships since their 1978 and 1979 wins. France collected the wooden spoon by finishing last for the first time since 1999. It was also the first time

every team managed to win at least 3 competition points (the equivalent of a win and a draw or three draws) since 1974. 02d04294b4 New Zealand won the tournament, defeating England 33-0 in the final. Attendance for the tournament was poor, with matches played in mostly empty stadiums. 02d04294b4

As the International Olympic Committee voted for the sport's inclusion, this was thought likely to be the last edition of the tournament. The team is run by the Rugby Football Union (RFU). Its history of the team extends back to 1871 when the England rugby team played their first official test match, losing 0–1 to Scotland. England dominated the early Home Nations Championship (now the Six Nations Championship) which started in 1883. Following the schism of rugby football in 1895 into union and league, England did not win the Championship again until 1910. They first played against New Zealand in 1905, South Africa in 1906, and Australia in 1909. However, the sixth tournament never materialized, and official literature referred to São Paulo as stop two of five. The first test was their first encounter since England's 13-9 victory over Argentina during the 2011 Rugby World Cup, and was the first time they have met in Argentina since 2009, the last time Argentina beat England. England won both matches of the series, completing their first series victory in Argentina since the 1981 England rugby union tour of Argentina, and winning both matches of a series in Argentina for the first time. 02d04294b4 This publication first appeared in 1887, produced by the Athletic News as a rival to the Football Annual. At the 2010 IRB Junior World Championship, they reached the semi-

2013 Rugby League World Cup final Their five-eighth, Johnathan Thurston was named man-of-the-match. Australia won the final by 34 points to 2 in front of a sell-out crowd, finishing the tournament undefeated. The Kangaroos won the Rugby League World Cup for the tenth time, and the first time since 2000. They reclaimed the cup from New Zealand, who had defeated them in the 2008 final. England national rugby union team They participate annually in the Six Nations Championship The England national rugby union team represents England in international men's rugby union. They participate annually in the Six Nations Championship with France, Ireland, Italy, Scotland and Wales. England have won the championship on 29 occasions (as well as sharing 10 victories), winning the Grand Slam 14 times and the Triple Crown 26 times, making them the most successful outright winners in the tournament's history. They are currently the only team from the Northern

Hemisphere to win the Rugby World Cup, having won the tournament in 2003, and have been runners-up on three further occasions. The England national rugby union team represents England in international men's rugby union 02d04294b4
