Childhood trauma has been correlated with later negative effects on health and psychological wellbeing. Children may go through a range of experiences that classify as psychological trauma; these might include neglect, abandonment, sexual abuse, emotional abuse, and physical abuse. They may also witness abuse of a sibling or parent, or have a mentally ill parent 73d12ab9e5

The term rape is sometimes casually used interchangeably with the term sexual assault. Cognitive behavioral therapy (CBT) has shown to be particularly effective in the treatment of trauma-related disorders and adapting CBT to an online format has been shown to be as effective as in-person CBT in the treatment of trauma. The progressive movement to online resources and the need for

more accessible mental health services has given rise to the creation of online-based interventions aimed to help those who have experienced traumatic events. Due to its positive outcomes, CBT-based internet treatment options for trauma survivors has been an expanding field in both 73d12ab9e5

There is no one set definition of a specialized violence court, although these types of courts can be either civil or criminal and typically hear the majority of an area's domestic violence cases on a separate calendar.
