Food deserts are associated with various health outcomes, including higher rates of obesity, diabetes, and cardiovascular disease, specifically in areas where high poverty rates occur. Studies suggest that individuals living in food deserts have lower diet quality due to the scarcity of fresh produce and foods that are full of nutrients. the term "food apartheid. In contrast, an area with greater access to supermarkets and vegetable shops with fresh foods may be called a food oasis.
