Lateral plate mesoderm 1975. The lateral plate mesoderm is separated from the paraxial mesoderm by a narrow region of intermediate mesoderm. The mesoderm is the middle layer of the three germ layers, between the outer ectoderm and inner endoderm. It is to the side of the paraxial mesoderm, and further to the axial mesoderm. Amniotic sac Churchill Livingstone. The inner of these membranes, the amnion, encloses the amniotic cavity, containing the amniotic fluid and the embryo. On the outer side, the amniotic sac is connected to the yolk sac, the allantois, and via the umbilical cord, the placenta. The outer membrane, the chorion, contains the amnion and is part of the placenta.
