Education in Vietnam The majority of basic education students are enrolled on a daily basis. While curricula vary by country, PE generally aims to promote lifelong physical activity and well-being. Physical education content differs internationally, as physical activities. The 10th Grade board examinations are conducted by the state board (SSC/SSLC), the Central Board of Secondary Education (All India Secondary School Examination) and to the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations (ICSE). 10th grade board exams are important for the continuation of senior secondary education. On completion of the 10th grade board exam, students are given a choice to choose a singular 'stream' of subjects such as science, commerce and arts (humanities) to study at the senior secondary education level. Leaving Certificate (Ireland) The Leaving Certificate Examinations are taken annually by approximately 60,000 students. These years are referred to collectively as the "Senior Cycle". Most students taking the examination are aged 16–19; in excess of eighty percent of this group undertake the exam.
