Business process management unique, then it is a project. The Business process management (BPM) is the discipline in which people use various methods to discover, model, analyze, measure, improve, optimize, and automate business processes. Processes can be structured and repeatable or unstructured and variable. Though not required, enabling technologies are often used with BPM.

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Any combination of methods used to manage a company's business processes is BPM. In business process management, a workflow can vary from case to case due to gateways, conditions, and business rules eba61d51e6

In software (and software-based systems) engineering, it is used to define and validate functional requirements. A use case is a list of actions or event steps typically defining the interactions between a role (known in the Unified Modeling Language (UML) as an actor) and a system to achieve a goal. The actor can be a human or another external system. In systems engineering, use cases are used at a higher level than within software engineering, often representing missions or stakeholder goals.
